Activities:

➤ General -

- ★ Activities play a vital role in the in the scholastic development of a child.
- ★ From Std. I to VIII , children are exposed to all the co- scholastic activities Performing various activities like , non – fire cooking, Rakhi making , Drawing and more. There are Projects and enrichment activities on learning experiences for all class levels.
- ★ All the activities are mentioned in school annual planner.
- ★ From std. I to VIII there are also inter house competitions and events planned through the year. Inter house dance competition, Inter house singing Competition, Fashion Show, Fashion designing , Inter house Skit competition etc. move towards specialisation and are based on their choice and interest.

➤ Specific –

Sports programme

- ★ Std. I to VIII (School Sports Day) have a general sports event day and is conducted in the school by trainers. These are undertaken to promote the active participation of all children. It provides sportsmanship skills to the students.
- ★ Special coaches are appointed to train the students all over the year.
- ★ For all the level many types of sports are organised in sports day like cycling race, sack race, hurdle race, skipping race etc.
- ★ Inter house sports competitions are also planned regularly.

Address:

- ★ Enter correct address in students diary (First page) and while filling the continuation form. The address filled in the diary will be used for all official records.
- ★ Please inform the school (in writing)of any change in address(contact no.house no.)correct address enhances the flow of communication.

Administration:

- ★ SH has always believed to make the administration approachable, transparent and open.
- ★ All Unit Heads and Coordinators are part of the administrative task force. They are independent to make decision or are the part of the process.
- ★ Parents should not believe in any verbal rumours as any circular, information and communication will be sent from administrative department in writing.

Admission:

- ★ Students are admitted on first come, first serve basis depending on vacancies.
- ★ Admission is open for all children irrespective of race, nationality, religion, caste and gender.
- ★ We conduct no formal interviews with the child or the parent.
- ★ Candidates will be required to make the fee payment within 7 days of the declaration of the results.
- ★ School reserves the right to admission in all matters pertaining to admission; the decision of the admission committee will be final.
- ★ Once the fee and documents are submitted, you will receive an Admission Confirmation Letter from the school. This will inform you about further formalities to be completed, if any.
- ★ Parents will be intimated of the date and time of uniform & textbooks issuance.
- ★ Your ward will be allotted the section on the day of admission. The time table will be handed over to your ward by the Class Teacher.
- ★ Kindly inform the school of your joining date. This is mandatory because staff need to be informed to expect your child on a particular day and they in turn need to make preparations accordingly.
- ★ Teachers will assist your child with the syllabi which has been covered in the class till date.
- Admission under RTE-
 - ★ 25% seats are reserved as per the guideline.
- Admission process under RTE-
 - ★ Family fills the online form on the RTE website.
 - ★ Once the school is allotted the school processes the admission after verification of document.
- Admission withdrawal-
 - ★ When written application and the requisite fee is received from the parents. A Transfer Certificate will be issued. Before withdrawing a student from the school one month's written notice or one month's fee in lieu thereof is required.
 - ★ No Transfer Certificate will be issued until all dues have been cleared.
 - ★ No transfer Certificate will be issued to a pupil whose name has been struck off the rolls.
 - ★ The pupil is absent from school for an indefinite period without written permission from the school.
 - ★ Those who leave the school in the month of May must in all cases pay the fee for the month of June.
 - ★ Fees remain unpaid for three consecutive months.

- ★ A parent behaves badly with any member of the school staff.
- ★ The application for Transfer Certificate if applied after the start of new session should be made in writing by the Parent or the authorized guardian of the pupil, along with a fee of Rs. 200/-
- ★ Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds
 - Disciplinary
 - Unsatisfactory progress in work
 - Detention in a class for consecutively 2 years
- Processing of Transfer Certificate –
 - ★ The Transfer Certificate Form once certified as ‘NO DUES’ from Class Teacher, Library, Accounts Office and Administration Department, is further processed for producing the ‘Transfer Certificate’ within 7 School office working days.
 - ★ If the withdrawal of admission is applied after the due date of school fees and the student has not attended the school even, then parent is liable to pay the installment for the respective quarter and late fee if applicable and only then the withdrawal application is taken for further process.
 - ★ In case of mid-term withdrawal, if the student has not attended the school in the respective quarter and the withdrawal application is given after the due date then the parent will be liable to pay the fee of that quarter to process with the withdrawal.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:

- ★ Once the student has applied for the admission and the student is successful and selected in the admission test, after paying the fees within due time limit, the school confirms the admission of the child. In case the child withdraws his admission and doesn't join the school, admission processing fee and one month tuition fee of the child will be payable by the parent to the school. Any refund after deduction of admission processing fee & one month tuition fee will be made (if applicable).

Appointment:

- ★ The first part constitutes a written test in General English, General Knowledge and two specific subjects applied for, by the Teacher.
- ★ This will be followed by 2 demo of class-room teaching
- ★ Finally a personal interview will be conducted.
- ★ The Appointing Authority may resort to direct appointment in specific cases.

Appreciations:

- ★ School has formed many ways for appreciation of the students as well as teachers and parents.
- ★ The student who participate in any programme/ Sports /Activities and excel with achievement, we upload all the participation list with winner in the website and social media. Certificate and gifts are provided for the same on school annual day programme.
- ★ The teachers, who play an important role in shaping students future deserve positive appreciation from you.
- ★ For the parents appraisal who has taken active participation for encouraging their child to take part in all the activities given certificate and gifts from the school and awarded in school's events.

Assembly:

- ★ During assembly students and teachers join collectively in the ground every morning for the Primary and middle School.
- ★ This is a space used for prayer, meditation, announcements, messages ,news and for positive thoughts , discussion ,general awareness, exercise and discussions of school rules.
- ★ Assembly time will be 8:00 am to 8:20 am. The appearance is compulsory for students and staffs for all levels.

Assessments:

- ★ Assessments covers Scholastic, Co- Scholastic and Co – curricular aspects. They are planned in such a way that Inter- learner comparison and fear of external examinations are minimized.
- ★ From Std- I to VIII Revision tests are conducted. These tests are for all subjects chapter wise. These tests are conducted weekly or after completing each chapter. Revision classes planned for the same. These test helps the teacher to check the gap in students learning and for teachers to do immediate remediation.
- ★ The score of these tests are maintained in Activity Registers the at the end of the year the cumulative marks are also added in the result of the students.
- ★ Students to maintain test marks index and to be signed by the teachers and parents both.
- ★ The structure of assessment for Std. I to VIII is as per the CBSC guidelines.

- ★ The same will be shared with the parents and students at the beginning of the academics session.

Attendance :

- ★ First day and last day of school after and before vacation is compulsory.
- ★ Attendance for Sports Day, Annual Day , or Events is compulsory.
- ★ 75 % of attendance is compulsory for classes up to class VIII.

Attendance for Parents:

- ★ Parents attendance is important on special events like annual day, sports day, PTM and all the days as and when mentioned in the school calendar.
- ★ Child feels encouraged and happy when they see their parents getting involved in his or her school life.
- ★ Attendance for parent orientation is mandatory.
- ★ PTM (Parents Teacher Meeting) is compulsory for parents to attend to know their child's progress.

Absent During Assessment:

- ★ If a child of class 1-4 is absent for a periodic test because of any valid reasons, can give exam later on but the exam paper will be changed.
- ★ If a child is absent in Final Term exam .He/She will be marked absent for paper and the score for that exam will be marked in Average.
- ★ If the child is absent in Revision Test .He/She will be marked absent for that test.
- ★ Leave will be granted during MT/FT exam for personal reasons like marriages, family functions etc.

Awards:

- ★ Rewards are given to the students as an appreciation card for those who are present during all the working days of every month.
- ★ Students are selected for the annual academic and all rounder awards on the basis of academics as well as co- Scholastic achievements (i.e who are very good in studies and taking part in all activities organised in school). For more information please visit to our website students section.

B

Bags :-

- ★ Students should carry proper size of bag according to their need.
- ★ Students to follow the routine provided at the beginning of the year and carry only those books which are pertinent in terms of homework or for exam preparation.. Extra books to be sent on request only .
- ★ This way the burden of extra weight is reduced for students.
- ★ Monitor your child's bag regularly. Unwanted material like- cell phones, makeup-kit and electrical gadgets should not be brought to school. These items will be seized.
- ★ It is not recommended to bring any valuable(like expensive ornaments ,watches etc.) The school is not responsible for any loss of goods and money.
- ★ Students are not allowed to bring money to school.
- ★ Tag all your child's belongings such as – water bottle, bag, shoes, sweater, stationaries, books and notebooks.
- ★ Carry napkin, water bottle, lunch box ,pencil box, stationeries, books and note books according to the time table.
- ★ Pens are used for writing from Std. IV onwards.
- ★ Students are not allowed to bring costly pens.
- ★ Students are not allowed to bring any personal belongings unless asked for.

Behaviour :-

For parents

- ★ Suitable usage of language, attitude and behaviour effect the quality of relationship you will create with the school and authorities.
- ★ Parents should be aware and intent to follow the school's rule and regulation.
- ★ Parents should make some disciplines for home as well.
- ★ Parents should collaborate with the school by executing the suggestion made by the school like attendance, arrival timing, lunch policy, dress code, security requirements.
- ★ Time- to -time counselling of the child by parents about their behaviour and their way of expression.
- ★ Complains regarding other children's from your child should be informed to school authority.

For Students

- ★ Students should follow gentle, calm and kind behaviour in school premises. They should address their teachers, all members of staff as well as their schoolmates with due respect and politeness.

- ★ Every child should understand that every action has a reaction. It will make the children to understand about his responsibilities for their actions, without damaging their self –esteem.

For Staff

- ★ All staff should follow norms of service rule book.

Birthday:

- ★ On birthday student can come in casual attire.
- ★ In class on birthday other children can wish him/her by singing.
- ★ Students may distribute toffees/chocolates only on their birthday.
- ★ Students can't distribute their birthday invitations in the class.

Books:

- ★ Students should take care of their books on their own.
- ★ In the condition of missing or loss of the books students should buy the same book to avoid missing out on lessons .
- ★ The teacher will make a note in the diary of the child if he/she attends the class without books/notebook.
- ★ If a student is absent then he/she takes the responsibility of the completion of the remained class work/homework. For younger children its parents responsibility to do the same for their child.

C

Calender:

- ★ Everyone should follow the school calendar for all the events, Holidays and vacations of the year.
- ★ Managements have the right to review policy regarding this.
- ★ Any changes due to any unforeseen situation, then it will be notified to you through a what's app message.

Circulars :

- ★ Regular circulars concerning announcement, events, and changes in calendar are sent via what's app.
- ★ Circulars are also available on our website.

Competition:

- ★ We provide equal exposure and opportunity to each and every child, to develop a cooperative spirit and give scope of 100% participation.
- ★ Competitions are focused on various skills, abilities and maturity to understand the concept of competition. It will also develop the ability to accept failure, to get introduced with appropriate events.
- ★ Inter – house competition and events are scheduled in the calendar for the all section of the children of the school.
- ★ Students will also be encouraged to be participate in inter –school events.

Curriculum:

- ★ Scholar's High follows NCERT/CBSE guidelines.
- ★ Books selection is based on NCERT/CBSE curriculum.
- ★ According to CBSE school should follow NCERT curriculum and base it's programme on National Curriculum Framework (NCF).

D

Detention

- ★ In the condition of not doing homework or for incomplete class work regularly consequence should be given.
- ★ Detention will be after school hours as required. The prior information about the detention should be given by the teacher.
- ★ The students will be required to be monitored by the respective teachers.
- ★ Parents will be informed in advance for detention classes.

Diary

- ★ All students must bring their diaries on regular basis.
- ★ The diary should be regularly maintained by the students and checked by the teacher.
- ★ Tearing of pages, scribbling unwanted details is strictly prohibited.
- ★ Parents have to sign on each page of the diary date wise.
- ★ Parents should supervise their child's homework/assignments.
- ★ In the students diary there will be all updates about their HW/CW.
- ★ Any changes regarding address or contact number must be updated to school office and the class teacher.
- ★ Notice of the lost of the diary should be informed to the class teacher.

E

- ★ E- Boards are used for Std IV –VIII for interactive learning.
- ★ E – Boards are always used by the authorised person. In the case of any damage the authorised person and class teacher will be responsible.

E- mail:

- ★ All the parents need to give valid 'Email ID' and what's app number to ensure smooth communication.
- ★ Check e- mails and what's app number for newsletters, updates, circulars and teacher communication.
- ★ Most of our communication, circulars etc.
- ★ Will be sent through what's app.

Events:

- ★ Various events are held throughout the academic year.
- ★ Most of the events are marked in the school calendar.
- ★ There are various inter- house events like Debate, Quiz, Sports etc.
- ★ The selection of the students is based on their capabilities will be final. NO special request for the same will be entertained. In inter school events, students' needs to be in school – uniform. The results declared also will be final. The school is not obliged to explain the results or the marking scheme.

F

Facilities:-

- ★ The school laboratories are well equipped such as Math lab, Science labs and the Computer lab.
- ★ The Library has all types of books and sufficient space. It should be technological equipped to plug in laptops and projects work.
- ★ Apart from this we have absolute spaces for music, dance and musical instruments.

Fees:-

- ★ Fees may be paid annually (Yearly) or Half Yearly (every six months) or Quarterly (every three months).
- ★ Fees to be paid at Punjab National Bank, Main Road, Ramgarh Cantt. Branch.
- ★ Please enter the Name, Class & Roll No. of your child in capital letters.
- ★ Parents are requested to follow the schedule for payment mentioned below:-
- ★ Non Payment of a Quarter Fee will result in discontinuation of van and other services.

LATE FINE:

a) If fees are not paid within the due date a late fine of Rs. 200/- per Quarter will be charged and is to be included with the next Quarterly fee.

b) @ Rs. 1000/- will be charged if the fees are not paid before the due dates of two consecutive Quarters.

- ★ One calendar month's notice in writing or one month's fee in lieu thereof is to be paid before withdrawal of a child from the school. School leaving Certificate will not be provided unless all fees are paid in full.
 - ★ All payment after the scheduled dates are to be made at the School's Office, along with the requisite Late fine by cash only.

Field Trips & Excursions:-

- ★ Educational trips provide experiences in a regular classroom- based teaching and focus on all aspects of learning.
- ★ Students get opportunity to learn through field trips.
- ★ Learning through fields trips with pre- and post- activities. Pre- activities include online reading about the topic and research in magazine.
- ★ Post- activities include projects, video, drama, etc
- ★ Parent volunteers are not allowed to go on fields trips

First-Aid:-

- ★ During school hours in case students gets hurt, parent will be called.
- ★ In case of an emergency student will be hurried and admitted to nearby hospitals (accompanied by our staff) and parents will be informed. All medical expenditures will be born by the parent only .Any bill paid by the school staff will need to be reimbursed.
- ★ For sick student first- aid and room are available to rest until the parents come to pick up the child.

Food:-

- ★ Children should carry healthy food to school like Rotis, Green Vegetables (No eggs or non-vegetarian items) will be allowed in Tiffin boxes.
- ★ If the child has any food allergy, parents have to inform in writing to the class teacher.

Forms/Documents:-

- ★ For our school records forms which are mandatory needs to be filled and submitted to the school office.
- ★ At the time of admission student need to submit the admission form, transfer certificate (Original), Birth certificate and self-attested Aadhar card and other documents required.

Furniture:-

- ★ Students should not write, scratch or engrave graffiti on desks, chairs and other surfaces. Those indulging in such nefarious activities are liable to strict disciplinary action.
- ★ It is the responsibility of each students to maintain and take good care of the school furniture.

G

Gifts:-

- ★ Students are restricted to give gifts to any staff of the Scholar's high. If they wish they can give anything in writing and handmade card are more valued.
- ★ If parents wish they could distribute stationeries to the students on their child's birthday after seeking permission for the same from the teacher in charge.

H

Home/Class assignment:-

- ★ The school gives regular projects and enrichment activities to the students.
- ★ If the student is unable to understand the topic, the teacher helps him/her.
- ★ If home assignment is not done by the students then message will be sent to the parents.
- ★ If he/she absent for the long period then parents have to ensure that they to covers the topics missed in homework and class work , teacher will only guide/help him/her.
- ★ During vacation home work/ enrichment activities are given to the student to keep in touch with school to make it enjoyable for students.

- ★ Projects will be made by students not parent. They will only guide them. Students will get clear instructions on the project in the class.

Houses:-

- ★ In order to inculcate the spirit of competition and cooperation among students, STD I to VIII are categorized into houses.
- ★ In four houses students are categorized.
- ★ Groups are divided keeping in mind that each house has children with mixed abilities .These divisions will be decided by and informed to the children. Any request for change in the same will not be entertained.
- ★ Asadhya (Red), Dhruv (yellow), Bhadrapada (Blue) and Saptarishi (Green) are the names of the houses.
- ★ Each house has 1 Captain, 1Vice-captain and 1 Prefect and they are elected by students through voting.
- ★ The student house will change every year.
- ★ For inter-house activities and competitions awards and trophies are given to the students.

I

Induction:-

- ★ We organise orientation to give a small demonstration to parents that how teachers teach.

Inter-school events:-

- ★ In inter-school events students are not charged any fee.

Allergies:-

- ★ If students have any allergies problem then inform the teacher.

Identity card:-

- ★ At the beginning of the year identity card will be issued to the students.
- ★ Students have to wear the identity card regularly as it is for the safety of the students.
- ★ In case Id-card is lost pay the extra charges to issue again.
- ★ It is necessary to update your child's Id-card whenever you change your address or contact number.

L

Language

- ★ Student must speak in decent language all the time. He must ensure that speech is courteous and polite.
- ★ Students should speak in English during school hours
- ★ We also request that elders at home should also model good spoken language in gatherings and in daily life .

Language Policy:

- ★ Students should be very polite wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their behaviour and conduct. Use of abusive language/ passing filthy or vulgar comments will invite stern action immediately.

Late coming

- ★ Entry into school premises is not permitted before 7:30 a.m. Late arrival will be permitted between 7:50 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. only three times in a month.

Learning Enrichment Process:

- ★ Periodical Programs for supporting students to bridge the gap for STD I - VIII.
- ★ In this program the extra remedial classes is provided to the selected students.
- ★ The students are selected for these classes are on the basis of teacher's observation and based on the academic performance.

Learning Materials:

- ★ SH provides teaching learning materials, art and craft materials for STD I – VIII. These are given at the beginning of the year or to use during the learning time.

Leave Policy for Students:

- ★ No child, having once come to school can leave during school hours or take half day except in cases of extreme necessity. Permission has to be taken from Principal/Coordinators.
- ★ Early leave permission will be granted only for medical reasons (if the child is unwell /hurt during school hours).
- ★ Pupil, who have been absent from class for more than 3 days, must have the reason entered in the regularity record stating briefly the cause of absence or delay. In case

of student is absent for more than 3 days, parents should send a letter stating the cause. In case of sickness/infectious disease, doctor's certificate is to be attached.

- ★ All long leaves must get prior sanction from the Class teacher/ Principal.
- ★ Regular attendance is very essential for every student. Percentage of attendance will be taken into consideration while granting promotions.

Lost and found

- ★ Pupils are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belongings. The school will not be responsible for the loss of their jewellery/wrist watches/ chains/ bracelets/mobile phone or any other belonging.

Library

- ★ Each student is issued a library card and can borrow one book at a time.

M

Management:

- ★ Activity management team organised all school event and programme.

Mobile phones:

- ★ Mobile phones are restricted in school premises.
- ★ If any student is found using his/her mobile phone within the school premises during school hours the phone will be confiscated and will not be returned to the student.
- ★ Parents to put their mobile phones in flight or silent mode while attending school meetings.

O

Olympiad:

- ★ It is a national level, an optional paid examination for STD -I – VIII.
- ★ The subjects offered for exam are English, Hindi, Maths, Science and **General knowledge.**
- ★ Before the examination subject teachers prepare the children for this.
- ★ Examination will be conducted after school hour only on the specified date
- ★ Parents need to come to pick up the child from school on the day of exam.
- ★ Student have to bring admit card for each exam.

P

Phone calls:

- ★ No phone calls are allowed for teachers/children during class hours.

- ★ Do not make phone calls to the principal. Contact on school number only.
- ★ Inform an hour before to change of plan regarding child going home.

Presentation :

- ★ Presentations are the part of each class activity.

Q

Questions – who will answer what!

- ★ Take the questions to respective unit Heads – Primary school / Middle school / Secondary and Senior secondary school / Admin.
- ★ Regarding academics matters – your child’s teacher, Coordinator / Vice Principal / Principal.
- ★ Administration related matters.
- ★ Accountant – About fees and accounts related.
- ★ Macro level policies – Director/Principal
- ★ Regarding admissions – Front desk
- ★ Regarding support services – Counselor/Special educators/Training in – charge

R

Reception:

Reports:

- ★ SH online academic performance Report is a detailed feedback report.
- ★ Online reports are issued after every major assessment.
- ★ Report is an important document and should be kept with you as record for future years.

Security:

- ★ School campus is covered by surveillance CCTV cameras.
- ★ Dedicated security staff ensures that no student leaves the gate without permission.
- ★ Make appropriate entries at the security when you visit school for any purpose.
